May 21 - Community Yoga

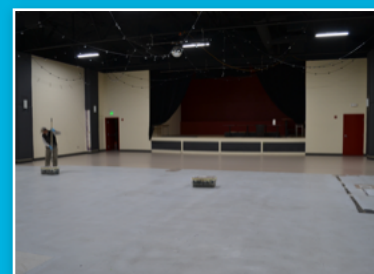
Master Planning Process begins

- How can a Cafe/Kitchen best serve the building?
- How can we best utilize the Gym/Event Space? What are the next levels of efficiency & sustainability improvements for Third Street?
