- Invite County Commissioners to meet at TSC
- Ability to shoot videos and podcasts
- Powwow at TSC with N. Ute / Ute and other tribes. or with your than using other tribes
- Rebrand center as Institute for Learning
- Third Street Institute: Economic and community development / sustainability / capacity building | workshops, trainings - online courses and catalogs
- Language Center; ASL, English as a Second language, Spanish tutoring
- Consider Third Street Center as part of the Town Recreation Tax.
- Space for small businesses / community serving
- Amphitheater for better use of outdoor space.
- Someplace special for outdoor events: plays, music, events, firepit
- Beautify / Gym / Windows / Plants
- Incubator space inside the gym space?
- Windows on west wall of Gym with garage doors that go up and down.
- Use Gym as conference center
- Pop the top off the building. Increase the density and mixture of uses - workforce development, business incubation, education for skills, and community functions
